**Executive Order No. 19 Series of 2022**

**CREATION OF THE LOCAL YOUTH DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL OF THE  
MUNICIPALITY OF MALILIPOT, ALBAY**

**WHEREAS**, Article 2 Section 12 of the 1987 Constitution states that “the State recognizes the vital role of the youth in the national building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual and social well-being.” It shall inculcate in the youth, patriotism and nationalism and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs;

**WHEREAS**, it is the duty of the municipality to reach out to the youth in the barangay and to encourage them to actively participate and be involved in its programs;

**WHEREAS**, the Local Government of Malilipot would like to ensure that the youth are given priority and that the programs and policies will be truly beneficial to them;

**NOW THEREFORE, I, CENON B. VOLANTE**, Municipal Mayor of Malilipot, Albay, by the powers vested in me by law do hereby order the Creation of the Local Youth Development Council of Malilipot.

**Section 2. Functions.** The LYDC shall perform the following:

1. Serve as the core of the advocacy on youth participation in nation-building and youth empowerment

2. Finalize the three (3) year LYDP that is anchored in the PYDP and the development plans of the local government units. The LYDP shall be initially drafted by the respective SK Pederasyon and shall be finalized by the LYDC. This shall be submitted to the LCE for inclusion in the Local Development Plan and subsequently endorsed to the Sanggunian of the local government unit concerned for approval. These plans shall give priority to programs, projects and activities that will promote and ensure the meaningful youth participation in nation-building, sustainable youth development and empowerment, equitable access to quality education, environmental protection, climate change adaptation, disaster risk reduction and resiliency, youth employment and livelihood, health and anti-drug abuse, gender sensitivity, social protection, capability building and sports development
3. Monitor and evaluate the implementation of the Local Youth Development Plan
4. Perform such other functions as may be prescribed by law or ordinance

**Section 3. Secretariat.** The Local Youth Development Officer shall be the Secretariat of the Local Youth Development Council.

**Section 4. Effectivity.** This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
